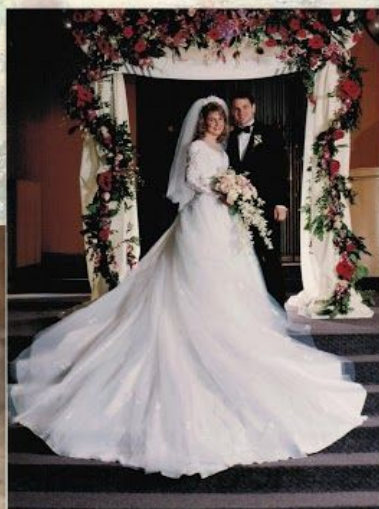
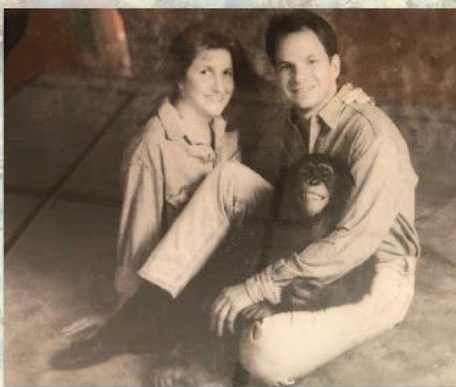

She is also a graduate of the Wexner Heritage Program and a member of Valley Beth Shalom synagogue.



About Our Legacy of Hope Honoree ~ Lisa Lainer-Fagan (continued)

Lisa is passionate about the intersection of genealogy and Jewish history and gives lectures about her family history research. She was a math major at the University of Pennsylvania, studied for a year at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and received her MBA at UCLA. She is the CFO at Selective Real Estate Investments. Lisa is married to Brian Fagan and is the proud mother of Ari, Zev and Sara.



2021 Recognition Award Recipient ~ California Senator Henry Stern

Senator Henry Stern is a sixth generation Californian, with family roots in the arts, agriculture and service. He was the first millennial ever elected to the Senate, and represents nearly one million residents of the 27th District, from Malibu to Magic Mountain, and Sherman Oaks to Thousand Oaks. An environmental and social justice attorney by trade, Stern is now beginning his second term as chair of the California Senate's key climate change and emergency management committees.

Since his struggles with anti-Semitism as a student leader, Stern has long held the Jewish community has an irreplaceable role to play in defending and upholding a diverse, secure and moral society. In his first term, he partnered with Hadassah to pass legislation cracking down on human trafficking, and led the charge to fund the Woolsey Fire recovery effort for local Jewish camps, and security grants for places of worship and community centers vulnerable to hate crimes and domestic terrorism.

Senator Stern's latest initiatives include the Never Again Education Act, a bill that addresses the lack of Holocaust education among younger Americans, by investing in teacher and student training, and modernizing statewide curriculum.





2021 Youth Award Recipient ~ Lexi Price

"I am passionate about history and Holocaust education. One of my most memorable experiences was traveling to Lithuania with the DLP in 2019, where I walked in artist David Labkovski's footsteps. In school, I learned about Nazi Germany and the Holocaust but never about the Gulags. Because of my experience learning with the DLP, I have much more clarity about this important part of history. I hope to help further their mission to share what I have learned with other people my age."

Lexi is an alumna of the International Student Ambassador Program, Spring 2019, is currently in the International Student Docent Training Program and we hope that she will be a leader in our new Virtual International Leadership Program for University Students. Lexi is a graduate of Yeshiva College, Johannesburg, South Africa and plans to spend a year in Israel furthering her education.





2021 Youth Award Recipient ~ Eva Trope

"The David Labkovski Project is an organization dedicated to education through art, which is a method that I think is so beautiful and real to teach the world about the Holocaust. The DLP's initiatives and exhibits are inspiring and the training program helps people all over the world understand this history and personal stories. I am proud to be part of this wonderful organization, and to enrich the world with these paintings."

Eva is an alumna of the International Student Ambassador Program, Spring, 2020, and is currently in the International Student Docent Training Program. She was part of the curatorial team for our recent exhibit presented with Holocaust Museum of Los Angeles. Eva is a student at Yeshiva College, Johannesburg, South Africa, where she actively volunteers and is part of the debate team. She intends to study law and aspires to be a judge in Israel.



About Our Speaker

DR. MICHAEL GOOD, a family physician from Connecticut, became interested in Holocaust history in 1999 when he accompanied his parents, both Holocaust survivors, to Vilnius, Lithuania. During this trip, his mother related her story of survival and spoke of a mysterious German army officer who had commanded her slave labor camp and who she claimed to have protected her, her parents, and over 1,250 Jewish slave laborers from the murderous intent of the Nazis. Following this trip, Good set out to find this enigmatic officer and to understand why a German army officer would have acted so benevolently at a time when his countrymen were committing atrocities on a previously unthinkable scale. In his book "The Search for Major Plagge," Dr. Good shares his parents' stories of survival and describes his search for the man who saved his mother's life.





DAVID LABKOVSKI PROJECT

The David Labkovski Project (DLP) advances knowledge of the Holocaust through the art of David Labkovski. Utilizing his history, paintings and sketches, the DLP works to fight hatred and antisemitism while emphasizing tolerance and the importance of bearing witness to history.

The David Labkovski Project offers the following programs:

- **International, Virtual University Leadership Program (students 18-22)**
- **Reflect & Respond Program for Holocaust Commemoration**
- **Teacher Training - The DLP works with educators enabling them to engage students through Labkovski's body of art**
The project based multidisciplinary curriculum allows teachers to guide students toward curating their own exhibit of Labkovski work for their community. The DLP Teacher Training Manual is now available to schools in English and Spanish
- **International & Virtual Student Docent training program for middle & high school students**
- **In class/virtual project-based instruction (16 hours)** culminating in a student curated exhibit of Labkovski work for the school community
- **In school workshops for students**

Keynote Lectures & Speaking Engagements

The David Labkovski Project offers keynote lectures with Leora Raikin, great niece of the artist. Leora is also the founder and executive Director of the DLP.

Exhibits – On site and/or virtual exhibits

Documenting History through Art

This exhibit follows the life of the artist, David Labkovski and the impact of historical events on his life. Time periods include: Labkovski's childhood in Vilna, Lithuania, his imprisonment in the Gulag in the Soviet union under Stalin, the Holocaust in Vilna, his time behind the Iron curtain (1946-1958) and finally Labkovski's renewal in Israel (1958-1999).

David Labkovski Brings Sholem Aleichem's Stories to Life

For artist David Labkovski, reading and illustrating the stories of Yiddish author Sholem Aleichem was a return to his own childhood in Vilna. From Tevye the dairyman to Motel the cantor's son, Labkovski illustrated the small, every day moments of life in the shtetl that Sholem Aleichem captured in his stories. Labkovski wanted to commemorate the Jewish "world that was" - not just how people died, but how they lived for centuries before the Holocaust.

Virtual Reality (VR) Step into the Past; Leap into the Future

Our cutting edge virtual reality component takes the 20th century artwork and integrates 21st century learning technology. The artwork has been transformed into an immersive experience. Join David Labkovski in the world of his childhood; it is a world that after the Holocaust no longer exists. The VR provides participants an opportunity to explore the “world that was” by stepping into Labkovski’s artwork, interacting with objects in a pre-war home, hearing about the lives of the characters in the paintings and exploring the Shulhof, synagogue courtyard.

Educational Resources for Teachers and Students

In response to online learning, the DLP offers teachers and students complimentary lesson plans and activities online. From poetry writing to coloring sheets, the DLP has answered the need for educational opportunities for meaningful online programming.

Highlights of 2020

2020 was not the year any of us could have anticipated. At the David Labkovski Project, we let our mission and vision to use Labkovski's art as a tool for education guide our work to engage, enrich, educate and empower students and audiences. Of course we missed being in the classroom and onsite for exhibits. However, the pivot to virtual programming allowed us to reach a diverse geographic audience with our exhibits, workshops, programs and unit of study.

Exhibits



Kwan-Fong Gallery at California Lutheran University

Prior to the pandemic, the DLP installed an exhibit of original artworks at the Kwan-Fong Gallery. It was only open on site for a week prior to the lockdown. The pivot allowed for us to create a virtual exhibit which has been visited by more than 1,500 people and counting.

Leatherby Library at Chapman University

It was only days from the installment of the exhibit, "Documenting History Through Art," that the University closed to onsite programming. In conjunction with the Rodgers Center for Holocaust Education we pivoted to an online presentation to engage the Chapman community with Labkovski's art.

Holocaust Museum Los Angeles

The DLP curated an online exhibit for the Holocaust Museum Los Angeles entitled, "Recalling a Lost World," David Labkovski Brings Sholem Aleichem's Stories to Life". To accompany the exhibit, the DLP led curator talks, lectures and educator workshops. We designed tools for teachers to use in their online classrooms including an online book of Aleichem's stories, illustrated by David Labkovski.

Student-Curated Virtual Exhibit, Loyola Marymount University

After participating in the DLP's unit-of-study, students in Dr. Feinstein's Literature of the Holocaust course curated, "Spoken Through the Visual: David Labkovski Contrasts Tragedy and Humanity." The exhibit was part of LMU's Kristallnacht commemoration program.



Highlights of 2020 (continued)

International Programs



Colegio Israelita de México adapted the unit of study for the virtual classroom. The students connected to Labkovski's artwork and then created a commemoration journal that can be viewed on the David Labkovski Project website, www.davidlabkovskiproject.org/commemoration-journals.html

Student Docent Training Program

The virtual student docent training program allows for students to share their thoughts on the artwork and the history to DLP audiences. Because the program was virtual, we were able to open the program to a wider audience. The current class of docents has students from 17 different schools and two continents!



Highlights of 2020 (continued)

Reflect and Respond Holocaust Commemoration Program



The DLP developed a **Reflect and Respond** program for community members to analyze Labkovski's work, learn the historical context and create their own work in response. Selected pieces were displayed and read during the first community Holocaust Remembrance Day commemoration program. View the online commemoration journal online, davidlabkovskiproject.org.

Workshops and Training Sessions
